Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (NTRO9509) affecting the C634 Paston Road / Mundesley Road / Bacton Road from its junction with The Dell to its junction with Hall Farm Road (the "Road") in the Parish of Mundesley to facilitate surface dressing works, the Road will be temporarily closed (except for pedestrian access) for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 14<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> May 2025, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 7<sup>th</sup> July 2025 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

NB: These works are to be carried out in 2 phases. Phase 1 is between 06:00 and 16:00 from 14<sup>th</sup> to 16<sup>th</sup> May. Phase 2 is between 19:00 and 5:00 from 23<sup>rd</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> May.

Alternative route is via: Bacton Road, Paston Road, Coast Road, Beach Road, North Walsham Road, Pollard Street, Crow Road, Mundesley Road, Lyngate Road, North Walsham By-pass, Folgate Road, The Street, Knapton Road, Knapton Green, High Street, Back Street, Station Road (Witton, Swafield, Paston, Bacton, Mundesley, North Walsham, Knapton).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: Norfolk County Council.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Road where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 7<sup>th</sup> July 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.


