

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (NTRO7757) affecting the Mundesley Road from its junction with Pond Road for 200m northwards in the PARISH OF PASTON to facilitate telegraph pole tests.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) on 25th March 2024 for the duration of the works expected to be about 1 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: B1159 Mundesley Road/ Bacton Road/ Paston Road/ Coast Road/ Beach Road/ Walcott Road/ Stalham Road/ Stepping Stone Lane, A149 Wayford Road, A149 Norwich Road/ Yarmouth Road/ North Walsham By-pass, B1145 The Street/ Knapton Road/ North Walsham Road/ Water Lane/ Stow Hill (Dilham, Worstead, Walcott, Bacton, Smallburgh, Brumstead, Swafield, Paston, Knapton, Stalham, Mundesley, East Ruston, North Walsham).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

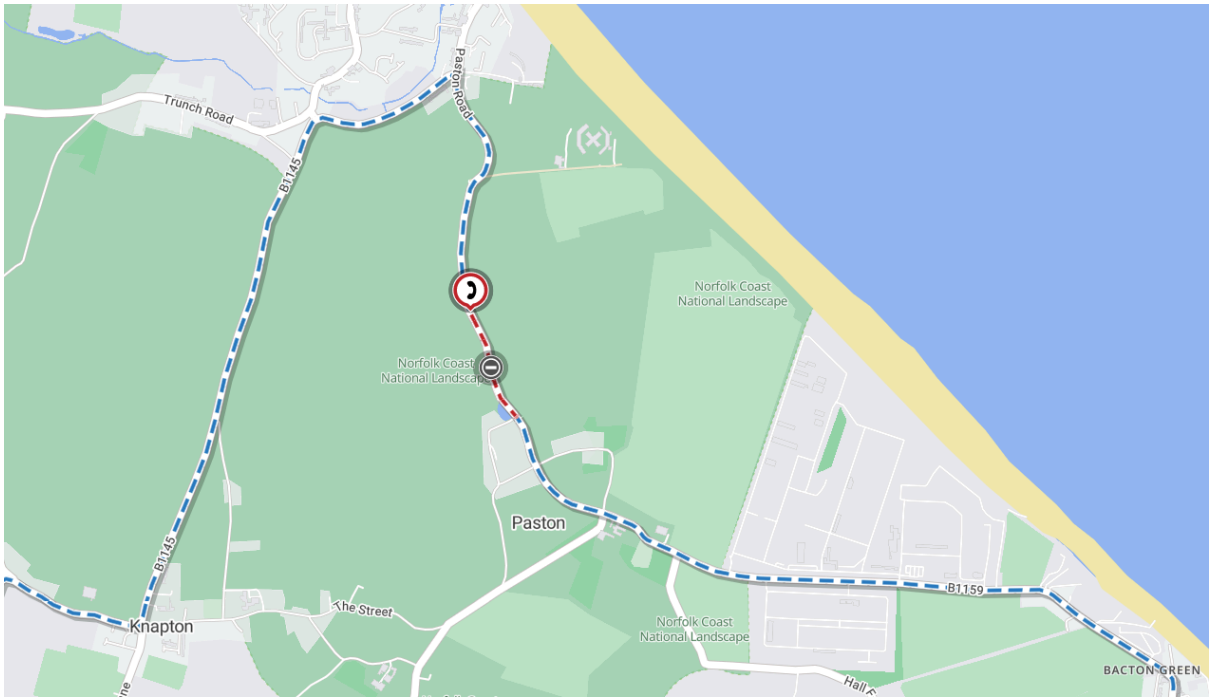
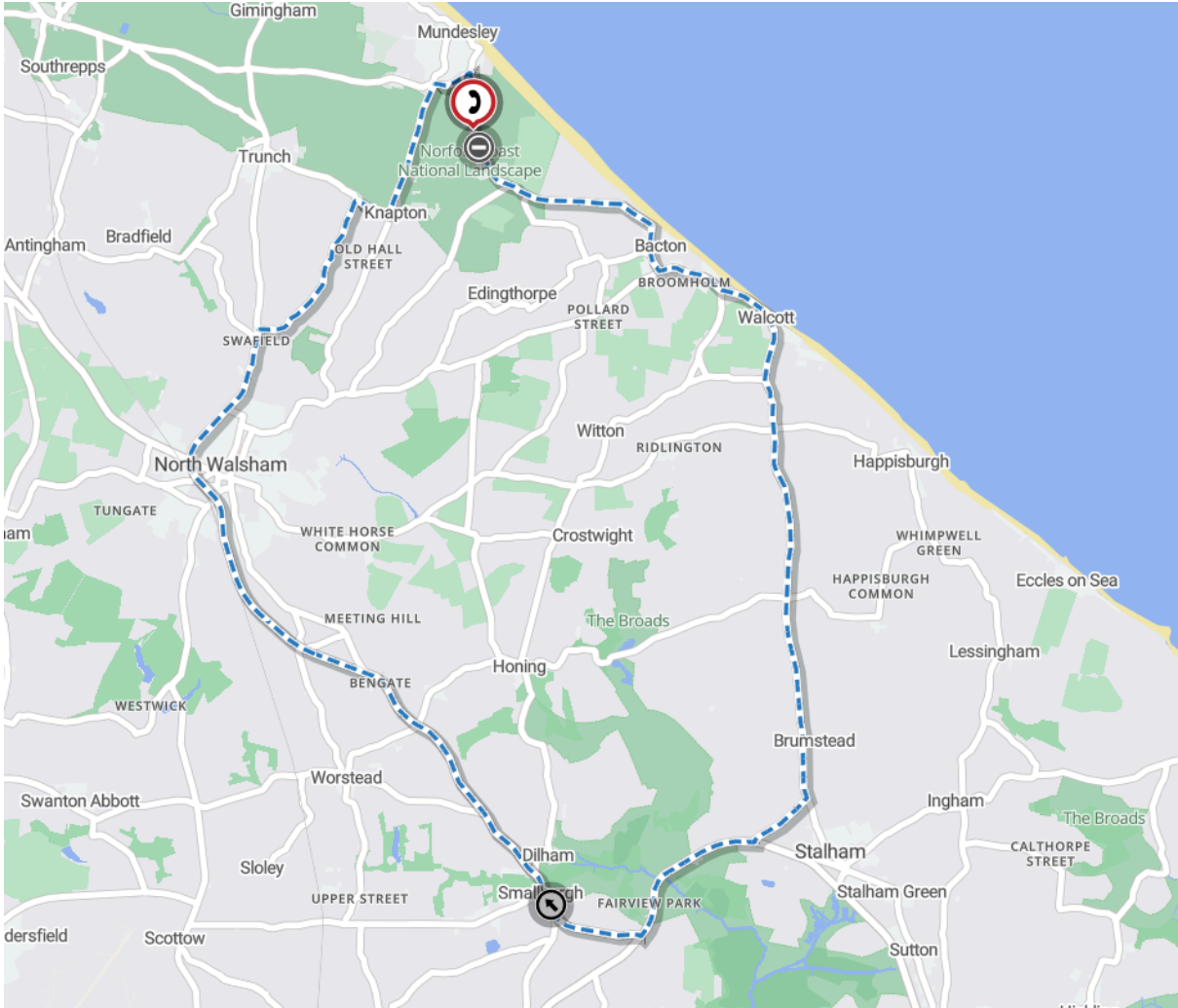
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
