

**Norfolk County Council (North Walsham)**  
**Emergency Notice**  
**Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2024**  
**Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

North Walsham (NTRO8936) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to burst water main the use by vehicles (of any class) of the Bacton Road from its junction with Little London Road to its junction with Hall Lane (the "Road") in the Town of North Walsham will be temporarily prohibited.

Alternative route is via: Bacton Road, North Walsham Road, Pollard Street, Coast Road, Beach Road, Paston Road, Mundesley Road, Stow Hill, Water Lane, B1145 Knapton Road/ Mundesley Road/ Knapton Road/ North Walsham Road/ The Street/ North Walsham By-pass, Lyngate Road, Crow Road (Witton, Swafield, Paston, Bacton, Mundesley, North Walsham, Knapton).

The closure is necessary because of the likelihood of danger to the public or serious damage to the road or both.

The closure is anticipated to take place from 27th November to 3rd December 2024 but the Road may continue to be closed until the 17th December 2024 where the closure is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works / when the closure is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 17th December 2024 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for an additional 21 days by further Notice and/or for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by further Order.

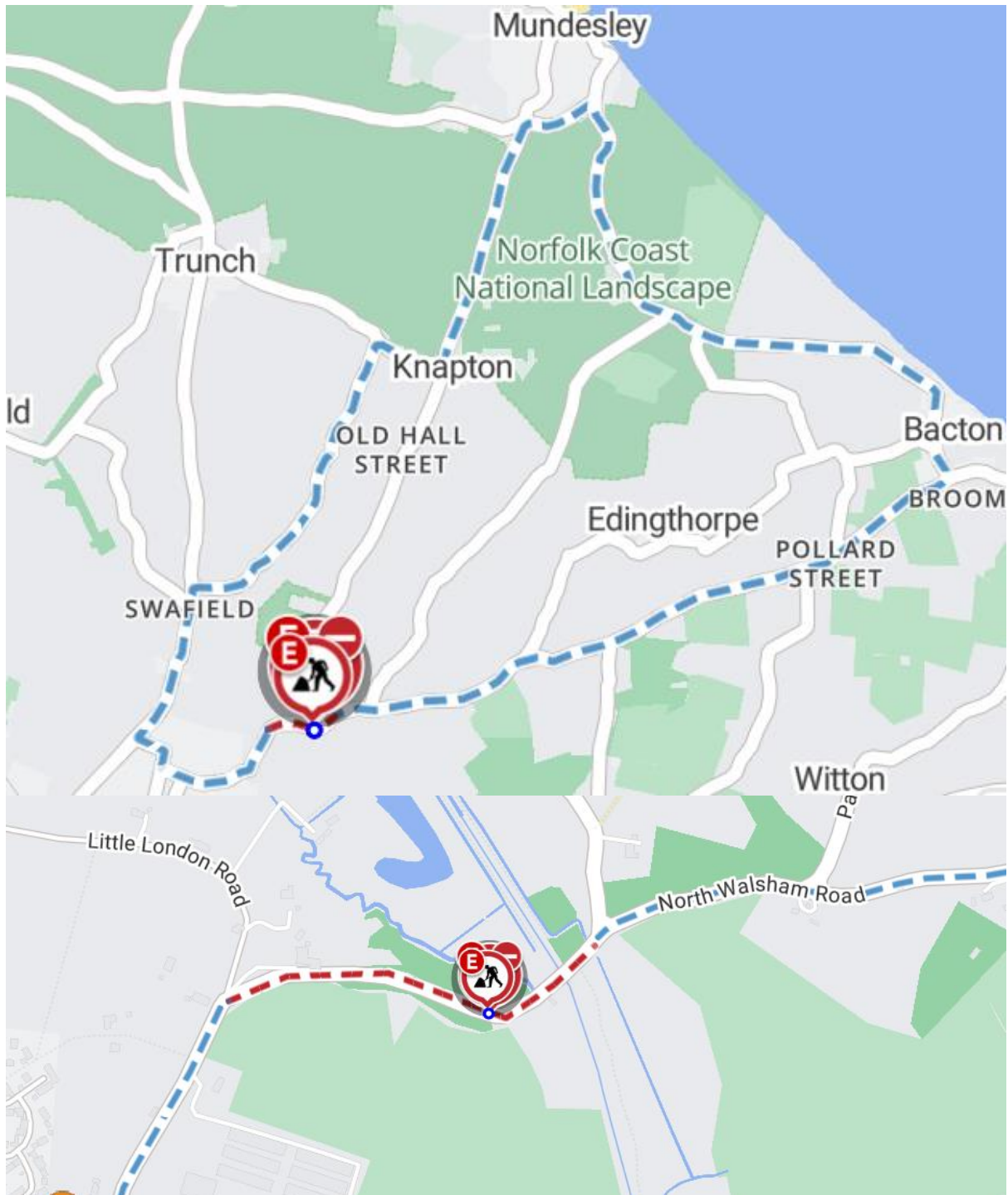
A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
