Norfolk County Council (Bacton & Paston) Urgent Notice Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2025 Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Bacton & Paston (NTRO9553) Notice

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to the installation of concrete barriers to enable essential gas works to be carried out the use by vehicles (of any class) of the Paston Road from 150m east of its junction with Hall Farm Lane for 1021m eastwards (the "Road") in the Parishes of Bacton & Paston will be temporarily prohibited.

The closure/restriction is necessary or expedient because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the Road.

The closure/restriction is anticipated to take place between 20:00 on 13th April and 05:00 on 14th April but the Road may continue to be closed/restricted until the 17th April 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

This Notice shall be in effect from 13th April to 17th April 2025 or until the closure/restriction no longer necessary, whichever is the earliest.

This Notice shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works when the closure/restriction is no longer necessary or otherwise on the 17th April 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, this Notice may be extended for a maximum of 18 months from the date this Notice is effective by an Order.

Alternative route is via: Paston Road, Coast Road, Beach Road, North Walsham Road, Pollard Street, Bacton Road, Crow Road, Mundesley Road, Lyngate Road, North Walsham By-pass, Folgate Road, The Street, Knapton Road, Knapton Green, Water Lane, Stow Hill (Witton, Swafield, Paston, Bacton, Mundesley, North Walsham, Knapton).

The works promoter for this restriction/closure is: National Grid Gas Plc.


A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/ closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
